

Dual Diploma Program Policies For academic year 2023-2024 Operated and delivered by Metiscenter in partnership with Hudson Global Scholars.

### **ADMISSION**

- Submit application with all required information, including a copy of passport ID page, parental/guardian consent form (if applicant is under age 18), applicable exam scores and school transcripts.
- Applicants without a standardized English exam score such as TOEFL or IELTS may be subject
  to an internal assessment unless the student's previous three years of school instruction
  were in English. A TOEFL score of 70+ or IELTS 6.0+ is recommended.
- A minimum GPA of 2.5 from 9<sup>th</sup> grade on, with no failing subject.
- Applicants must have completed 9<sup>th</sup> grade before program start date. Special consideration may be given to applicants still in 9<sup>th</sup> grade on a case-by-case basis.

### PROGRESSION TO UNIVERSITY

To qualify for direct admission to partner universities, the student must observe the following conditions:

- Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5 within the PCDGC program, with no course grade below C.
- Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5 within the student's local high school curriculum.
- Have obtained the PCDGC diploma and a local high school diploma prior to university enrollment.
- All outstanding balances of tuition and fees must be paid in full.

Note: Prior to entering the US to study, students must obtain a US visa, which is at the sole discretion of the US State Department. Metiscenter and the universities are not responsible for issuance of the visa.

## **Academic Policies**

- Extension: A student may request an extension to complete a course. Extensions are charged per week beyond the course end date, with a minimum of 2 weeks and a maximum of 6 weeks. The student must submit a request for extension to the local course instructor prior to the end of the course. No online live instruction from the lead Instructor will be provided.
- **Incomplete Grade**: An Incomplete will be assigned if a student has not completed the required number of assignments in addition to the final exam by the end of the course.
- Retake: If a student gets an Incomplete or a D in a course, the student may request to retake
  that Course for an additional fee. The student must inform the local course instructor prior to
  the course end date.
- Withdraw: A request to withdraw from a course must be submitted in writing to the local course instructor no later than 20 days prior to the course end date. Tuition and fees are nonrefundable for withdrawals.
- **Transfer**: A student may transfer from a course within 10 days of the course start date. No more than two transfers is permitted per program.
